Visit esp.uq.edu.au and check your eligibility. ESP applications are open to current Year 11 students in Queensland. For most courses, applicants must be achieving at a high level.

Complete the online application form at esp.uq.edu.au and upload your Semester 1, Year 11 report card. You must also upload a permission form signed by your parent/guardian and school principal.

Applications open early August and close Thursday 31 October 2019.

* Adjustment factors were previously called bonus points. Please note that adjustments are not on ATAR scores. Each ATAR is converted into a selection rank and this rank is then adjusted. Please contact UQ Admissions for further information.
