The following information is provided to assist domestic students who have completed or are undertaking the UQ College Tertiary Preparation Program (TPP) and intend to seek admission to undergraduate study at The University of Queensland (UQ).

About the UQ College Tertiary Preparation Program

The UQ College Tertiary Preparation Program (TPP) is intended to equip school leavers and adult learners with the necessary academic skills and knowledge to undertake successful tertiary study. The program is 32 weeks in duration and has one intake in March each year which is delivered at the UQ St Lucia campus. Students may choose to complete the entire program or undertake individual subjects.

The full Tertiary Preparation Program (TPP) consists of 2 core subjects: Academic English plus ONE of General Mathematics or Mathematical Methods; and 3 elective subjects.

Entry requirements

For entry to all undergraduate programs at UQ applicants must meet two basic entry requirements:

1. Eligibility (i.e. satisfy the subject prerequisites and other requirements)
2. Merit (i.e. possess a selection rank high enough for a place in the program[†])

[†] Selection ranks range from 1 to 99.95 (maximum). As admission is competitive the minimum selection thresholds for programs can fluctuate from year to year.
